RESEARCH INTERESTS

- Secular iconography and religious allegory in late-medieval and early-modern European art (14th-17th century): creation and reception of new allegorical images; historical definitions of ‘sacred’ and ‘secular’ art; censorship of religious images based on their connection to secular themes.
- Natural images and *acheiropoietas*: medieval and early-modern scientific theories concerning images found in the natural world (plants resembling sculptures, veined marble slabs perceived as paintings, etc.) and their link to the religious concept of *acheiropoieton*, a miraculous image ‘not made by human hands’.
- The representation of political power and the shaping of dynastic memory through artistic patronage and writing, with a particular focus on north-western Italian courts (Saluzzo and Savoy families, 14th-19th century).
